## **Zero tolerance on Vaping:**

Again I want to highlight the issue of vaping. Any student found **Vaping** or in possession of **Vaping** materials on school grounds will be suspended. The Board of Management fully supports this rule and has ratified it. Students who are vaping in the toilets are showing huge disrespect towards their peers who want to use the toilets. Toilets will be randomly supervised and if there is a group of students standing around with even one student vaping, all students in the group will be suspended. If there are two students in a cubicle, both students will be suspended.

Students must be signed out through vsware app by parent/guardian and must wait at reception to be collected. If a student leaves the school without signing out at the office, this is recorded as mitching school

Mobile Phone Policy During the school day from 8am to 4pm (while on school grounds) and during Evening Study, mobile phones must be powered off and out of sight. An exception may be made where a student uses their mobile phone to monitor a pre-existing medical condition. We must be informed of this in advance. In the case of an emergency, parent/guardian may contact the school office to speak to their child, you should not phone your child directly as their phone must be powered off. This policy was adopted as mobile phones are a major distraction and a disruptive influence for our students during class. If a student breaks this rule, their phone will be kept at the office for two days and two nights.

If a student is feeling unwell they must report to the office first with their teacher's permission and knowledge (Health & Safety reasons) and the office will contact home if necessary.
